

Manual for Quokka 1.1

Installation

If you have not downloaded Quokka yet, you can grab it on mr-fridge.com. When you've downloaded it you've got a .dmg file. Open it. Drag the Quokka icon on the Applications Folder.

License

Quokka is shareware. You can use it for free in demo mode which allows you to do 15 paste actions before it quits automatically. If you like the program you can buy a license key on our website <http://mr-fridge.de> to get all features unlocked. (Naturally you may not share your license key.)

All our Software-Licenses include a Green-License which means that if you want to use the Software you have to do something against Climate Change or Pollution. It is up to you what you would like to do, but of course, doing more good is better. We suggest doing things like

- replace a conventional light bulb with an energy efficient CFL-bulb
- go to work by bike (of course: bicycle not motor cycle)
- buy a new fridge
- or just put your computer to sleep when you leave for lunch

All these actions will reduce your Carbon-Foot-Print and also save you money. For example, replacing a conventional light bulb will save you about €16 per year (including acquisition costs). That will payoff the price of a €5 software product within 4 months. A new Fridge or not using your car will result in an even greater bargain. Nice, isn't it?

To use Quokka you must read and agree to the attached end user license agreement (EULA).

How to use Quokka

Start Program

Start Quokka by double clicking the program icon.

On the first start you will see a Welcome Window which gives you some initial information. You can always show this window by clicking "Quokka Help" in the

"Help" Menu.

Copy and Paste

You have access to Quokkas clipboards from every application:

- press cmd+alt+1, cmd+alt+2, and so on up to 0 to copy something to the clipboard
- press ctrl+alt+1, ctrl+alt+2, and so on to 0 to paste the clipboards content.

It is just as easy to use as the clipboard integrated in Mac OS X which of course is still accessible.

You can change these keyboard shortcuts in the Preferences

Clipboards Window

Quokka can show you the contents of all your clipboards in a floating window. This automatically opens on the first start but of course can be minimized to the Dock or be closed completely.

You can always show this window again via the "Show Clipboards" menu item at the "Window" menu.

If you copy a picture, sound or anything else that has no text representation Quokka will show you the name of the Application from which you copied the data. For example if you copy a picture from iPhoto the Clipboard Window will show you "iPhoto data" in the appropriate clipboard view.

Any restrictions?

You can copy and paste anything with Quokka but the copy/paste action is only performed when you release the keys of your keyboard shortcut. As long as you keep the shortcut keys pressed, Quokka does nothing.

Preferences

The Preferences window offers you two tabs. In the Shortcuts tab you can change the key combinations through which you access your pasteboards. Changes only take effect when you click apply.

At the Settings tab you can adjust if the program icon should appear in the dock or if you want to have it in your menu bar. Here you can also set if Quokka shall automatically start when your computer starts.
